## 2007 Christmas Tree RECYCLING

Curbside collection of Christmas trees will take place from Wednesday, December 26, 2007 through Friday, January 11, 2008. Covina Disposal will collect Christmas trees with a separate vehicle on your regular trash collection day. Please note that refuse service will be delayed one day during the weeks of December 24, 2007 and December 31, 2007.

Please place tree at curbside next to barrels and remember to remove ornaments, nails, tinsel, and stands. Flocked trees or trees coated with fire retardant will also be accepted. Residents who live in multi-family complexes that use bins will have their trees collected at curbside on the regular trash collection day for single family residences in that area. Trees will be collected free of charge and hauled to the landfill to be used as alternative daily cover.
