4. Will my trash rate change?

Athens offers residents and businesses competitive bundled recycling, organics, and trash service rates.

5. Will my service day remain the same?

Athens will change some days to reduce the number of trucks in the City. New service days will be communicated in advance of the January 1, 2022 start date.

6. Will residents be receiving new waste containers?

Yes, Athens will deliver brand new carts and will coordinate the removal of your old ones. Each household will receive a standard bundled package, including one cart each for recycling (blue), organics/food scraps (green), and trash (black).

7. Who do I contact if I have questions?

You can contact the local customer service center at (833) 791-2377. Customer service is available between Monday - Friday, 8:00 am - 5:00 pm and Saturday, 8:00 am - 12:00 pm. In addition, our Self-Service Options are available 24/7 at <u>AthensThousandOaks.com.</u>
