RE: Annual Solid Waste Rate Adjustment

Dear Valued Glendora Customer,

Athens Services is dedicated to providing a world-class experience to each customer. As part of our commitment to you, we make it a priority to provide transparent and timely communications regarding your services.

What is Changing in Your Community?

Effective July 1, 2026 your waste and recycling collection rates will reflect an increase of 5.0% in accordance with the terms of the City of Glendora franchise agreement. This adjustment is based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI), as well as the increased costs of organics collection and processing as required by Senate Bill (SB) 1383. This rate modification will apply to all residential, commercial, and multi-family customer service rates.

Note: This annual rate adjustment is authorized under the City's existing Franchise Agreement with Athens Services and is separate from the Proposition 218 notice recently issued by the City of Glendora regarding proposed future maximum service rates.

Why are Rates Changing?

In today's economy, the cost of fuel, labor, and equipment continue to rise at an accelerated pace. Rate adjustments are necessary to offset the increasing costs of collection, recovery of organics and recyclables, and the disposal of non-recoverable waste. This adjustment will allow us to continue to provide the highest level of service you have come to expect from Athens.
