HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW)

Latex Paint (Water Base), Automotive Batteries, Motor Oil, Antifreeze, Used Oil Filters

UNIVERSAL WASTE

Electronic Waste (TVs, Computer Monitors, Printers, Microwaves, Flat Screens TV, Tablets, Laptops, keyboards, mouse cables and speakers), Alkaline Batteries, Lithium Batteries, Ni-Cad Batteries, Fluorescent Lights, Compact Fluorescent Lights



NOT ACCEPTABLE

Oil Based Paint, Toxics, Poisons, Corrosives, Flammables, Combustibles, Irritants, Brake Fluids, Paint, Thinners, Pesticides, Medical Sharps, Medications, Mercury, Marine or Road Flares, Explosives, Ammunition, Radioactive Materials, Tires, Household trash
